



Peace Lutheran Senior High Ministry (9th -12th)

Mission: For senior high students and parents to develop their identity as servant leaders and nurturing their spiritual gifts of service, justice, witness, and sense of belonging in the Christian community.

Goals: To provide education, service, worship, fellowship, and experiences which will enable:

1. Developing the opportunity to help the students and families to realize the significant of their baptism into Christ and join with others in sharing their story.
2. The encouragement of developing their sense of call in doing ministry with the world.
3. The opportunity to develop their identity as agents of witness and justice by serving in the world.

Fellowship/Service:

Wednesday Youth Group: These events will be held on every Wednesday from 7:00 -8:30 pm on the church grounds, however the time and place may vary for special events such as service events or fellowships off campus. Each Wednesday we will have a meal together to share our ministry with each other. Although this is mostly a fellowship, there is a “vital 15” where the final 15 minutes of together we come to pray for each other.

Sr. High Events: These events are going to be held on the weekend following the second Sunday of the month on the church grounds. The time and the place may vary for special events and other holiday activities.

Summer Mission Trip: Every summer, the sr. high youth schedule a mission trip to help outside of the community.

Prayer/Study:

Sunday School: Sunday education which will focus on activating the faith of our children and bringing back these lessons to the family unit for further discussion and development of family. Sunday school is every Sunday at 9:45 am-10:45 am.

Milestone Ministry: Blessings and classes that are held at Peace to help uplift important events in the lives that have an important impact on the faith development of the family and children. The following are geared towards sr. high and families: Beginnings, Drivers License, Rated R, Graduation, Anniversary of Baptism, College

Confirmation – Every Sunday evenings from 6:00-7:30 pm, students will come to help in leadership of the confirmation program, this can be done through a majority of ways which can be developed differently each year.

Worship/Leadership:

Youth Council: This is to give our adults an opportunity to serve and help in a leadership with the development of the ministry. This is multi-generational council, but the council is there to help the director of youth and family ministry in discerning the progress of the ministry. Meetings are once a month and time and meeting is depending upon the council.

Worship Studies/Service: Families and youth are given an opportunity to serve in multiple roles in the development of the worship. These can be service opportunities or educational, but that will depend on the needs of the community at the given time.

Summer Ministries: There are two ministries offered to children, Camp Hope and VBS. Camp Hope is our outreach summer camp ministry program which offers a 3 week program of music, games, arts & crafts, kitchen time, splash days, small groups and bible study for children. VBS is our Sunday School outreach ministry which focuses on the evening fellowship, study, and activities which invites the community to come together. Sr. High have the opportunity to be paid staff with Camp Hope and have to attend a training to help in their spiritual and leadership skills.
