



Peace Lutheran Young Adults Ministry (Ages 18-25)

Mission: For young adults and parents to have an open place for young adults to formulate their foundation of their identity and help in their search for Christian intimacy in a welcoming community.

Goals: To provide education, service, worship, fellowship, and experiences which will enable:

1. Developing the opportunity to help young adults realize the significant of their baptism into Christ and to share their faith journey with others.
2. The encouragement of developing their own voice in their community.
3. The opportunity to develop their identity as a Christian by giving young adults a space to develop their own identity.

Ministries Offered:

Fellowship/Service:

Chillin Group: These events will be held on every Sunday evening from 8:00 -9:00 pm on at either a local coffee house or pub, however the time and place may vary for special events such as service events or fellowships at other sites close to the congregation. This is an opportunity to get away from school and work to just get to know each other and share our stories.

Young Adult Events: These events are going to be held on the weekend following the fourth Sunday of the month on the church grounds. The time and the place may vary for special events and other holiday activities.

Prayer/Study:

Sunday School: Sunday education which will focus on activating the faith or hot topic issues during the Sunday school time which is every Sunday at 9:45 am-10:45 am.

Pub Talks: This is an open forum where people can come together and share questions of faith or life issues. Open to those that are not able to come to Chillin, but must be at the age of 21 to attend.

Worship/Leadership:

Youth Council/ Church Council: This is to give our adults an opportunity to serve and help in a leadership with the development of the ministry. This is multi-generational council, but the council is there to help the director of youth and family ministry in discerning the progress of the ministry. Meetings are once a month and time and meeting is depending upon the council.

Worship Studies/Service: Families and youth are given an opportunity to serve in multiple roles in the development of the worship. These can be service opportunities or educational, but that will depend on the needs of the community at the given time.

Summer Ministries: There are two ministries offered to children, Camp Hope and VBS. Camp Hope is our outreach summer camp ministry program which offers a 3 week program of music, games, arts & crafts, kitchen time, splash days, small groups and bible study for children. VBS is our Sunday School outreach ministry which focuses on the evening fellowship, study, and activities which invites the community to come together. Young adults are given an opportunity to be mentors for sr. high or jr. high leaders.
